



YEAR END HI POINT Awards

The Goulburn Valley Reining Horse Association (GVRHA) Hi Point year runs as per calendar year. Points will be allocated from the following shows: February, March, April, June, September. The GVRHA Buckle Up & Slide Show held during May is NOT included in the allocation of points.

To be eligible to receive points, riders must be a financial member of the GVRHA at the time of showing. Riders must have competed in a category at a minimum of two (2) of the five (5) shows throughout the year to be eligible to receive an end of year hi point award for that category.

Points will be determined by a sliding scale based on the number of entries in the class, Eg: 10 entries in the class; 1st place = 10 points down to 10th place = 1 point. Tied placings will receive equal place points. A score of 0 will not be allocated any points.

Points will be awarded on a 'one horse-one rider' combination in the following categories:

- GVRHA Green Rider
- Rookie L1
- Rookie L2
- Limited Non Pro
- Intermediate Non Pro
- Non Pro
- Youth 13 Years & Under
- Youth 14 – 18 Years
- Prime Time Non Pro
- Novice Horse Non Pro L1
- Novice Horse Non Pro L2

Points will be awarded to the 'horse' in the following categories:

- Novice Horse Open L1
- Novice Horse Open L2
- Limited Open
- Intermediate Open
- Open

Points will be awarded to the 'rider' in the following category:

- Rookie Professional

The highest total of points from each category will receive an end of year Hi Point Champion Award. Runner Ups will receive a certificate.

If a final equal total of points results in a category, the winner will be determined by the highest aggregate scores over the year in that category.
